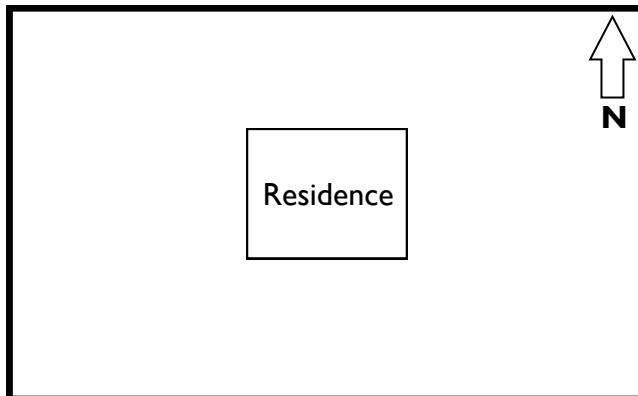

50/50 Tree Planting Program 2022-2023

Through its 50/50 Tree Program, the Village of Winfield shares the cost of planting parkway trees with homeowners on a split cost basis. All residents that have room on a public parkway are eligible to participate. Residents simply choose which tree(s) they want and send in a check for the resident contribution amount listed. The Village handles the rest. Information on available trees is included in this brochure.

Trees will be planted by a contractor in the parkway adjacent to your home. Each tree is a minimum of two inches in caliber, and comes with a watering bag as well as a one year replacement warranty.

Participants should plan to refill the watering bag 1 to 2 times a week to ensure the tree transplants successfully.

To be eligible for the program, trees should be planted 40 feet apart from other trees on all sides, 4 feet from any curb or sidewalk, and 30 feet from intersections. Village staff will confirm the planting location and handle all of the planting details. **Trees purchased will be planted in spring 2023.** Private property trees are ineligible for this program.

There is a limited budget for the program and orders will be accepted first come-first served until the budget is expended. Orders, with checks payable to the Village of Winfield, must be received by **September 9, 2022.** The price listed for each tree is the homeowners share of the tree cost. The Village offers an alternative for residents who wish to plant a different tree species than provided in the 50/50 brochure. In addition, the Village offers a cost-sharing program for homeowners associations with private parkways. Please visit the Village website or contact Village Hall for more details.

Native Flame American Hornbeam (*Carpinus Caroliniana*)

American Hornbeams are very adaptable trees to many soil types. This variety does produce flowers in the spring, and small nutlets in the fall along with a vibrant red color. Grows at a slower pace, up to 35 feet in height at full maturity. 2" - 3.5" sizes available. Starting cost : \$190



Heartland Catalpa (*Catalpa Speciosa*)

This Catalpa is suitable for all soil types and narrow parkways. It is a medium-size tree that produces large white flower clusters in the spring, and thin bean-like pods in the fall along with a yellow color. Grows at a fast pace, with a mature height of 50 feet. 2" - 3.5" sizes available. Starting cost: \$188



London Planetree (*Platanus acerifolia*)

The London planetree is a large, fast growing tree, tolerant of all soil types. Growing to 80 feet, it exhibits small and colorful flowers in early spring, with minimal fruit produced with this "Exclamation" variety. 2" - 3.5" sizes available. Starting cost : \$183



Red Oak (*Quercus rubra*)

The Red Oak is a medium-large and fast growing tree. Suitable for most soil types with some drought tolerance, it has a bright to dark red fall color. Grows up to 75 feet in height at full maturity. 2" - 3.5" sizes available. Starting cost : \$201



Hybrid Elm "Triumph" (*Ulmus Triumph*)

Developed by the Morton Arboretum, this hybrid has a strong resistance to Dutch elm disease, elm yellows, and elm leaf beetle. This tree is quick to establish and grow with a mature height of 60 feet. This tree is also adaptable to most soils and exhibits a bright yellow fall color. 2" - 3.5" sizes available. Starting cost: \$188
